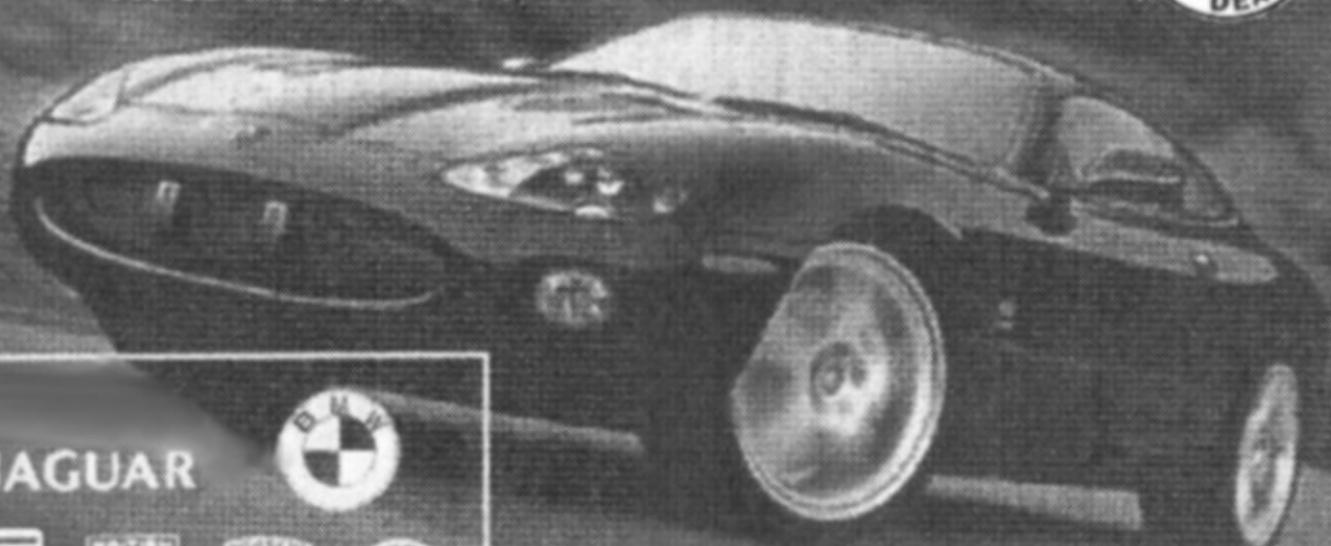



Among the JANE members attending, most of whom also judged, showing their cars were as follows



Object of event: Each entrant will drive to several selected locations as noted on the JANE Poker Run Direction Sheet and will collect 5 playing cards. 


